The Weekday Early Education program provides quality care in a safe and secure environment that promotes the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual growth of each child. The WEE Program uses a Bible-based curriculum that supports the values and beliefs of First Baptist Church Hendersonville.

WEE Classes meet August-May on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday from 9 AM-3 PM.

Classes are available for children 6 weeks old - Pre-K 5.

CLASSES

BABIES - The baby program focuses on meeting each child's basic needs in a safe, loving environment. As the child grows and begins to explore God's world, teachers use Bible stories, pictures, music and exploration during playtime to help each child understand that God created them and loves them.

1-YEAR-OLDS - One-year-old classes are designed to provide hands-on experiences that encourage creativity and discovery. Bible stories, process art, music and playtime, teach children social skills as well as introduce early academic concepts.

2-YEAR-OLDS - The twos program emphasizes age-appropriate academic skills as well as social skills using imaginative play, individual creativity, hands-on learning, and music & movement. Biblical concepts are emphasized through role play and exploring God's world.



3-YEAR-OLDS - Three-year-olds learn and play in a structured environment. Bible stories, small group instruction, learning centers, and exploratory play are designed to build on academic and social readiness introduced in earlier age groups. Emphasis is placed on teaching skills that will give the child a greater sense of independence and confidence.

4-YEAR-OLDS - The fours program strives to collaborate with parents to bridge the gap from pre-school to elementary school. Bible stories, learning activities, play, and school readiness skill instruction are used to prepare the child to enter Kindergarten confidently.

PRE-K 5 - The Pre-K 5 program is designed for children who are old enough to attend Kindergarten but need another year to build their social & school readiness skills. Bible stories, academic instruction, learning centers and exploration aim to boost confidence, creative thinking, problem solving skills, and social well-being.

Bible stories & units are the same for all age classes each month.



RELATED ART CLASSES

MUSIC (2-yr-olds-Pre-K 5)

In Music, children sing and move, play instruments, and learn simple music theory. The most important thing they do is learn how to praise Jesus! Classes participate in an end of the year program in May.

DISCOVERY (2-yr-olds-Pre-K 5)

The Discovery class explores the amazing world God created for us. Units of study include animals, the weather, five senses, community helpers, colors and much more.

SPANISH (3-yr-olds-Pre-K 5)

Hola! This class introduces children to the Spanish language. They learn number, color & shape words as well as other Spanish words and phrases that go along with classroom units of study.

BIBLE & BOOKS (4-yr-olds & Pre-K 5)

The Bible and Books class helps children experience the Bible and the joy of reading. Children will each have their own Bible in class and learn to navigate through it as they explore Bible truths. Games, songs, and additional book reading will engage the children each day and help them begin a life-long love for reading.



THE SUMMER PLAYHOUSE PROGRAM uses Bible stories, art, snacks, games & learning centers to teach children about our yearly theme. 2-year-olds - Pre-K 5 also attend Music & Discovery each week.

Classes meet in June & July on Tuesday & Thursday from 9 AM-3 PM and are available for children 6 weeks old - Pre-K 5.
