Go, Baptize, Teach By Emily Davis

"Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey

everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'" Matthew 28:16-20

Here at the end of the book of Matthew, Jesus commands the eleven disciples to go, make disciples, and baptize those who believe. Jesus' sending out is not possible without the authority of Jesus, his teaching and training of the disciples, and his promised presence. First, it is Jesus who has the authority and the power to commission the disciples to go out and invite all the people of all the earth to be Disciples of Christ and to be baptized. This is a huge task, and it cannot be completed unless all authority does belong to Jesus and is given to him by God.

Second, Jesus' commissioning comes only after training and worship together. These disciples had been followers of Jesus, watching him and asking questions of him. They had been learning and practicing, and on the mountain that day, they saw Jesus and worshiped him, even though some had doubts. Only after they had followed Jesus, been discipled by him, and worshiped him does Jesus send them out to invite others to do the same.

Lastly, with this command, there is a promise that Jesus will be with the disciples always, to the end of the age. It is a promise of

Jesus' constant and ongoing presence with them. In order for the disciples to go into the world with everything that Jesus taught, Jesus must have the willingness to be present with them always. Jesus sends them out, but he does not leave them alone in that work. He will comfort them and guide them throughout their lives and ministry.

A Word of Gratitude and Goodbye By Emily Davis

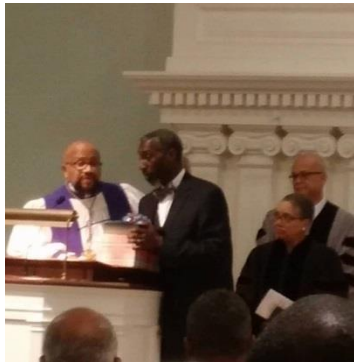
